Dear Sir:-

We are in receipt of your letter of the 12th inst., relative to the purposes for which automobile license and gasoline tax funds may be expended, and as to the expenditure of village funds for poor relief.

Sections 5309-2, 5537 and 5541-8 G.C., governing the expenditure of automobile license and gasoline tax funds, expressly provides that such funds may only be used for the maintenance, repair and construction of streets, except that one-fifth of the total amount received from gasoline taxes may also be used for cleaning streets and maintaining traffic lights.

You are further advised that under the provisions of Sections 3476 to 3494 G.C., it has been held by the Attorney General that village funds may not be expended for poor relief, but that such relief to residents shall be furnished by the township, and to non-residents from county funds.

Dear Sir:

Your letter of July 7, 1932 addressed The Mayor, Venedocia, Ohio was handed to me Tues. evening July 12, 1932. The Council at a regular session last evening July 14, 1932 owing to the financial condition of the Village, decided that nothing could be done in the way of an air-marker. I answered Mr. Vorys Director of Aeronautics during Governor Cooper's administration and Mr. McKee Director of aeronautics during the fore part of Governor White's administration explaining the condition of the village financially.

The general fund from which we must draw has less than Forty Dollars. Our Feb. draw was less than Seventy Dollars and our August draw will be very small. Owing to the condition of our finances we were compelled to ask The Central Light and Power Co., Findlay, Ohio to shut off street lights for four months May, June, July, and August. Our street lights are twenty-five dollars per month. It can be readily seen that the village will be hard pressed to meet its street light bill this coming autumn and winter. Certain necessary improvements must be delayed and have been delayed for two years and a half because of the lack of money. This village is situated partly in-York and partly in Jennings Tps. Van Wert Co., Ohio.

Having no school of its own it pays to the maintainance of a Centralized ~~Grade~~ school in York Twp. and a centralized grade school in Jennings Twp. I am informed that 65% of taxes collected in this village go to the ~~above~~ named schools. Were it not that the village has a contract with the ~~above~~ named light co. the Venedocia Village Corp. would revert back to the Twps.

I regret that the village must answer in the same strain each time.


