

Dear Sir:

Attached herewith are five copies each, namely a five year Rate Ordinance providing for a schedule of rates to be charged residential, commercial lighting and small power customers in your village, and a ten year Street Lighting Ordinance which covers the present installation of ten street lamps and provides for any additional street lights you may wish to install. Each of these ordinances grants a reduction in rates over the ordinances now in effect.

It is also agreed, in accordance with your meeting held on Tuesday the 18th, that you shall continue the use of the street lights thru the months of May, June, July and August of this year on a 50% cost basis as provided by the schedule, or at the rate of \$10.00 per month for those months as mentioned. Thereafter or beginning with September 1st the full time schedule shall take effect. The part time lighting as you understand, of course, is only a temporary arrangement and in no way alters or modifies the terms and conditions of the contract.


I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 7th, relative to the monthly minimum charge of commercial customers.

An amended ordinance was passed on June, 1931, reducing the commercial minimum from \$3.00 to \$1.00 per month, which was a special concession granted at that time. This was done due to the low monthly consumption of four or five customers in Venedocia, at any rate none of them using 30 kilowatt-hours per month. Our recent ordinance passed cancels the monthly minimum charge of such places of business from \$3.00 as shown by the original contract to \$2.50 per month as shown on our last rate ordinance passed.

It might be that we will be able again to offer some concession to four or five customers mentioned in your letter and would suggest that you notify each of them to pay the bill as rendered, which they have already received, and we will make our adjustment on next month's billing.

William G. Jones served as a member of the Council of the village of Venedocia for a period of almost four years. The week ending September 16, 1933 saw his last service for the public. Tuesday evening, September 12, present at a regular session of the Council, the evening of September 14, at a called session of the Council. Saturday morning, September 16, as one of a committee of three, looking after a matter of interest to the town, proved to be his last act for the public. When the Council met in regular session October 11, 1933, Mr. Jones was seriously ill, passing through the valley of the shadow of death. At the meeting of the Council, November 14, 1933, these words were applicable to the occasion: "William G. Jones's body lies moldering in the grave but his soul--real self--goes marching on."

The Council and other officials of the village wish to express their sympathy to those members of the family, near and dear to him--to his daughter, Mrs. Bessie Burnett and family; to his sons, William and Elvin; and to the several sisters and brothers of the departed.


Dear Mr. Edwards:
