AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE PRICE WHICH CENTRAL OHIO LIGHT & POWER COMPANY SHALL CHARGE FOR LIGHTING THE STREETS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF VENEDOCIA, OHIO.

BE IT AND IT HEREBY IS ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Venedocia, Van Wert County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That beginning with the effective date of this ordinance and continuing for a period of ten (10) years, Central Ohio Light & Power Company, its successors and assigns, shall furnish electric service for the lighting of the streets, alleys, and public places within the Incorporated Village of Venedocia, Ohio upon the conditions and terms set forth in this ordinance.

Section 2. That Central Ohio Light & Power Company, its successors and assigns, shall hereunder furnish, install and maintain for said Village of Venedocia, Ohio all the necessary and proper equipment for lighting its streets and public places at such points as the present street lights are now located, said street lighting service to be paid for monthly by the Village in accordance with the below terms and conditions and rates:

First 100 kwh used per month \$.045 per kwh
All Over 100 kwh used per month03 per kwh

The Minimum Charge shall be \$7.50 per month

The above street lighting service shall be furnished each day from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise. The street lamps shall not be less than 100 watts each in capacity, and the wattage of same may be increased at the option of said Village.

Section 3. That on or about the first day of each month the Company shall render a bill to said Village for each month's lighting and the Village shall pay said bill on or before fifteen (15) days after date of bill.

Section 4. The Village, upon the passage of a proper resolution by the Council and upon written notice to the Company, shall have the right to add additional lights of the type and character presently in use at such places and from time to time as are deemed necessary; provided, however, that the Company shall not be required to install any additional lights more than 600 feet from any light in operation at the time of the said notice.

Section 5. Said Village shall, by motion duly passed by its Council, at any time have the right to change the location of lights, but at an expense to the said Village of the actual cost required by the Company for such change, the same to be payable to said Company upon presentation of an itemized statement of the cost.

Section 6. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

GIVING CONSENT OF THE VILLAGE OR CITY TO THE REMOVAL OF SNOW
AND ICE FROM ALL STATE AND FEDERAL HIGHWAYS IN

Venedocia

UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS, The Director of Highways is considering the matter of snow and ice removal under his supervision of the State or Federal Highway (s) in Venedocia

WHEREAS, (U) S. R. # 116 within this village (lie in whole or part)

WHEREAS, It is proposed to remove snow and ice on said State Highway, or Federal Highway into, within or through this village along the aforesaid State or Federal Road

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Ordained, by the Council of the Village or City of Venedocia State of Ohio.

SECTION 1: That it is declared to be in the public interest that the consent of said village be, and such consent is hereby given, that said (U) S. R. # 116 above described may be cleaned of snow and ice under the supervision of the Director of Highways.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk be, and he is hereby directed to furnish to the Director of Highways and to the Board of County Commissioners of Van Wert County, Ohio, a certified copy of this Ordinance immediately upon the taking effect thereof.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
