GRANTING DIRECTOR OF HIGHWAYS AUTHORITY TO MAINTAIN STATE HIGHWAYS INSIDE VILLAGE CORPORATION

WHEREAS, The Director of Highways, under Sec. 1178-42 of the General Code of Ohio, is authorized to maintain extensions of state highways within the limits of a village, and
THERMAS, Extensions of State Highways No lie within this village, and
THERE'S, The work proposed to be authorized under this ordinance shall be restricted to general maintenance of the travelled roadway surfaces of the State Highways hereinbefore set out, and
MHEREAS, It is understood that this ordinance shall not in any way obligate the State of Ohio to repair pavements or roadway surfaces damaged by the repair removal or installation of subsurface utility lines, and
WHEREAS, This ordinance shall in no manner relieve or discharge the said village from any claim or claims of any nature arising from, or growing out of, the maintenance by the Department of Highways of the State of Ohio of said highways in said village, and the said village shall save the State of Ohio harmless from any and all such claims,
