LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Brethren and Sisters:

We present to you another annual report. This contains the record of our church activity for the year 1918. As you study it and behold the enrollment of your name, we pray that you will ask yourself the question: Have I done my best, both in contribution and in general faithfulness to the cause of Jesus Christ, or have I been a slacker?

During the war, the term slacker was a very common epithet, descriptive of the one who refused to co-operate in war activities and who failed to manifest active sympathy with our country and its allies in the fight against the enemy. The slacker: we all deemed an undesirable and a reproachful character. Virtually, he was a traitor!

Beloved, the war between light and darkness, between right and wrong, between Jesus and Satan is still on! And in this conflict it behooves us as Christian Soldiers to beware lest we be slackers.

The Bible warns us against slacking with God's work. Deborah condemned the slackers of Meroz, for, said the heroine "they came not to the help of the Lord, to the help of the Lord against the mighty." Those foolish virgins again were slackers, because they neglected their opportunities and privileges. The man of one talent also belonged to this class, since he failed to invest his talent in active service for his Lord. That sad company on the Judge's left hand faced eternal gloom, because they had been slack in doing the Lord's will. God help us then to heed these warnings and shun being slackers.

While this report indicates that the large majority of us have been faithful in contributing to the support of our church and to the sustenance of the missionary societies, Home and Foreign, it is silent—necessarily so—concerning our spiritual graces. Cold type can say nothing of our inner spiritual lives. It cannot speak of our attendance or lack of attendance in the mid-week service and the Sabbath worship. It cannot reveal whether or not the "family altar" has its due place in our homes. Neither can it manifest whether there be in our characters any growth in likeness to Jesus Christ. We must make these things a subject of prayerful self-examination.

During the past year, eight of our ripest members—five from Salem and three from Zion—entered the Church Triumphant! While the vacancy caused by their departure is keenly felt; by us who remain, we nevertheless rejoice that the number of the Redeemed in Heaven has been thus increased by eight saints from our midst.

The year 1918 will ever be memorable to us as marking the departure of many of our young men for the military camps, and then for overseas service. We are justly proud of our men-at-arms! Nineteen hundred and nineteen will be characterized by their return to us. What element does the church mostly need to welcome back her young men? We answer, a more intense spirituality, yielding fruit in greater devotion and consecration to Jesus Christ in all life's spheres. THEY have quitted themselves like men in the service of their country and in the cause of humanity! God grant that upon their return they shall find US fervent in spirit, faithful in service, loyal in allegiance to the Captain of our Salvation.

"And now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy: To the only wise God our Savior, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen." Jude. 24-25 vs.
