FOREWORD

Dear brothers and sisters—

We are presenting again to you our Annual Report, and we hope that every member will carefully read and examine it. It is published so that you may have a detailed account of what is done, and if you will not read it, that purpose is to that extent frustrated.

This is a special year in the history of this community. It is the 80th anniversary of the arrival of the Welsh pioneers, and next year will be the 80th anniversary of the founding of the church. We think that it would not be amiss at this season to direct each other's attention to the noble efforts of these pioneers.

Before the church was founded our forefathers had the prayer and the Seiat meetings. They dug deep for a solid foundation upon the rock of spiritual reality, and they built upon that rock. The little that we have of their history is an inspiration to all who read it. A PRAYER MEETING AND A SEIAT WITHOUT A CHURCH, that was the history of these pioneers for months. No church and no ministry, but a prayer meeting and a Seiat every week. We cannot but reverence these men. How many are there who know nothing about the prayer meeting and the fellowship meeting? Can we build as well for the future without these as our forefathers built with them? We think not.

The most modern thought in religion brings us back to what was a common place with the founders of this community, namely, the need of expression in religion. These men gave expression to their religion, and thus became men of strength. We need the same.

We are glad of the splendid work that is being done with the Juniors and those in charge deserve of sincere thanks.

We have also the Christian Endeavor for the Young People, and the week night service for all, and we should be thankful for what is accomplished in these services. But we know that more could be done, and the exhortation given unto us is to press on to perfection.

The church is the hand maid of God to carry His purposes in the world, and He depends upon it. This work is left unto us, and in order to do it effectively we need to plan so that we work unitedly, we need to move together. We sometimes sing

Like a mighty army moves the church of God
and every soldier in the army keep step. We need the same in the church.

The thought that is impressed upon us this year is to recognize that all is of God, and that we are God's servants. Paul gladly recognized that he was God's slave, and so are we. The words of Tennyson are true

Our will are ours, we know not how,

Our wills are hours to make them thine.

and as our wills are His, so is everything His. Our time, our talents, our all, is His. And if we will act upon this truth, all these will become ours in a much more real sense that they can come otherwise.

May this truth sink deep into our hearts this year, and may we use all the means at our disposal to further this end.
