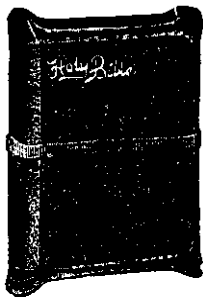

## FOREWORD

Presenting its record for the year 1934-35, in this concise and detailed fashion, Salem, Venedocia brings home to its entire membership the measure of their cooperation in their own church enterprise.

As an occasional friendly and interested visitor, the writer has had some opportunity of sensing the spirit which has animated the work, at best only partially caught in these physical evidences and figures. Even so, such visible items do tell an impressive story—a story of financial obligation, freely assumed and fully met; of a Christian fellowship made glad by coming of new members and saddened though not disheartened by the departure and falling on sleep of beloved leaders and friends; of regular services maintained without abatement; of much labor of love rendered by a host of willing workers in the interest of children and youth; and of a flourishing church school. Special note should be taken of the women's society and the brotherhood. The ministry of music has not been overlooked.

It is a good augur that the Memorial fund for the perpetuation and increasing stability of the church meets with growing favor.

This, however, is not all. The motivating spirit has been more than the body. One is very much tempted to dwell upon that indefinable somewhat that makes the living church—the true fellowship of believers. Within these wheels we have observed unquestioning faith, amid some discouragement, that the church is an indispensable institution in the community, impressively worth while with a gospel to proclaim, a charge of holy living, and a loving service to keep, and a God to glorify. We have observed a noteworthy faithfulness, even when deprived of the inspiration of a regular pastor, on the part of youth as well as manhood and womanhood in the maintainance of church standards and ideals.

And we have been witness to the rewarding glories of Christian experience—in the bird's song of hearts made glad on bended knee and in the eve'n song of peace as tired fellow pilgrims have said farewell to earth.
