#### Dear Fellow Churchmembers:

New programs and new concerns for building up the physical structures and improve our own worship center with the purchase of a new organ and to worship in a newly decorated sanctuary ... ought to stimulate our faith to set us on the way in a new concern for the priorities of faith, witnessing and reaching out into the community for the cause of Christ and his kingdom. This is a year when exciting things are happening in the area of Evangelism. The **PRIORITIES** that **YOU** establish in **YOUR** life will determine what our church will do in the coming year.
